Dear Parents,

The children have been focusing on healthy eating this week and recording what healthy foods they've had at lunchtimes. We also had a visit from the school nurse on Wednesday to talk about healthy living and lifestyles. You might like to discuss healthy eating with your child and encourage them to eat healthily and get into good active habits for life.

The Farway Fledglings have been making Valentine Cards this week and using scales to weigh different toy animals.

On Tuesday it was Safer Internet Day and the children were involved in activities about how to use the internet safely and their responsibilities when using it. The Key Stage 1 children read and discussed the story about Digiduck and how being mean on screen is the same as being mean in the playground; people get upset so we need to think about how you would feel if someone put something on the internet about you. The children did a quiz about different scenarios and drew posters promoting the theme of 'thinking before putting images on the internet'.

The Key Stage 2 children discussed the idea of being an 'Upstander' rather than a bystander; how they could help people who had been upset or hurt by things going on the internet and how to promote good practice when using the internet. The children discussed various scenarios and case studies. They then performed a play reading about how a character's actions and lack of action had affected others throughout his life, both for good and bad.

You may wish to discuss their understanding of how to use the internet safely and responsibly. Our question of the week links to this area.

Last week we had a tie for the Orchard Aims points competition with reds and yellows scoring 14 points each. The competition is very tight as we reach the mid-point of the term's competition.

The children all have a small homework project for over the half-term break which will be due in during the week back after the break. Please support them with their research, designs and presentations, encouraging them to produce their best work.
